A travel and nature photographer for 43 years Jim has logged more than 2.5 million miles covering the world to create captivating award winning images. His work has been seen in more than 60 magazines worldwide and with over 3000 calendar images, 30+ articles and 5 books his work is prolific. Among his many awards are the World Environmental Photography Award, ForeWord National Book Award for best travel book of the year, and the Colorado Book Award for best pictorial book of the year and the International Photography Awards. His *Colorado Scenic Byways; Taking the Other Road* was selected as the Governor's gift for the 2008 Democratic National Convention as well as the official gift of the State of Colorado.
